Third Call for Proposals: The Energy and Environment Partnership Programme with Southern and East Africa (EEP-S&EA)

The Energy and Environment Partnership Programme with Southern and Eastern Africa (EEP-S&EA or EEP, for short) seeks good and innovative project proposals concerning renewable energy and energy efficiency for grant part-financing. EEP is funded by the Ministry for Foreign Affairs of Finland and Austrian Development Agency and hosted by the Development Bank of Southern Africa (DBSA) in Midrand, Johannesburg, South Africa.

Means of Submission: **Only Online Submissions allowed, no email submissions will be accepted**

Opening of Online Submissions: **Thursday 7 April 2011**

Deadline for Submission of proposals: **Strictly Friday 15 April 2011 at 13h00** South African time.

Key Differences from Previous EEP Call for Proposals.

Unlike previous EEP Call for Proposals, only online submissions at the EEP website will be accepted this time and no submissions through emails will be accepted. Proposals can be submitted to the EEP Regional Coordination Office ONLY through the EEP website www.eepafrica.org. The proposals are strictly required to be submitted in the online format and no other format will be accepted. A worksheet of the online application form is attached for your perusal and this has also been made available on the website. To save you time, you are kindly advised to print the worksheet and prepare all that is required before proceeding to fill up the form online. It is also very important to familiarize yourself with all the changes in the application requirements by reading the Application Guidelines first before proceeding to fill up the form online.

The maximum grant allocated to a project will be €200 000 and all applicants are required to provide some level of own contribution. Please check the Guidelines for details on this.

To be eligible, your proposal should be implemented in one or more of the partner countries which are Botswana, Kenya, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, Swaziland, Tanzania and Zambia. Regional proposals involving two or three countries are also welcomed.
